#### Song of Songs 2:8 - 10

# Come With Me

Elijah = 'My God is Yahweh'

- Baal = 'lord, husband'
- Root word: 'to marry'

Baal is a false Christ, Christ is the True Husband to Gods people.



- Brook 'nachal'
- Flows from a fountain; from rain and snow on the mountain.
- A torrent, 'an outpouring'
- Cherith 'cutting'
- Speaking of covenant
- 'which is before' or 'that flows from'
- 'Paniym' = Presence.
- Jordan Descender



#### J.I. Packer, in his book, 'Knowing God'

"Balance is the most horrible, self-conscious word to the genuine Christian. The question is, can we say, simply, honestly, not because we feel that as Christians we ought to, but because it is a plain matter of fact, that we have known God, and that because we have known God the unpleasantness we have had, or the pleasantness we have not had through being Christians, does not matter to us. If we really knew God, this is what we would be saying."



#### 1 Kings 17:4 - 7

"'And it will be that you shall drink from the brook, and I have commanded the ravens to feed you there.' So he went and did according to the word of the Lord, for he went and stayed by the Brook Cherith, which flows into the Jordan. The ravens brought him bread and meat in the morning, and bread and meat in the evening; and he drank from the brook. And it happened after a while that the brook dried up, because there had been no rain in the land."

#### 1 Kings 17:8 - 10

"Then the word of the Lord came to him, saying, 'Arise, go to Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon, and dwell there. See, I have commanded a widow there to provide for you.' So he arose and went to Zarephath. And when he came to the gate of the city, indeed a widow was there gathering sticks. And he called to her and said, 'Please bring me a little water in a cup, that I may drink."

### Zaraphath = Refinery

**COME WITH ME** 

"...Zarephath, which belongs to Sidon..."

- Zarephath 'refinery'
- Sidon 'hunting; as in catching fish'

Sidon was the stronghold of baal, ruled by King Ethbaal (of baal) who was Jezebels father.

#### 1 Kings 17:11 -13

And as she was going to get it, he called to her and said, "Please bring me a morsel of bread in your hand." So she said, "As the Lord your God lives, I do not have bread, only a handful of flour in a bin, and a little oil in a jar; and see, I am gathering a couple of sticks that I may go in and prepare it for myself and my son, that we may eat it, and die." And Elijah said to her, "Do not fear; go and do as you have said, but make me a small cake from it first, and bring it to me; and afterward make some for yourself and your son.



#### 1 Kings 17:14 - 16

For thus says the Lord God of Israel: 'The bin of flour shall not be used up, nor shall the jar of oil run dry, until the day the Lord sends rain on the earth.' So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and he and her household ate for many days. The bin of flour was not used up, nor did the jar of oil run dry, according to the word of the Lord which He spoke by Elijah.

#### 1 Kings 17:17 - 18

Now it happened after these things that the son of the woman who owned the house became sick. And his sickness was so serious that there was no breath left in him. So she said to Elijah, "What have I to do with you, O man of God? Have you come to me to bring my sin to remembrance, and to kill my son?"



#### 1 Kings 17:19 - 22

And he said to her, "Give me your son." So he took him out of her arms and carried him to the upper room where he was staying, and laid him on his own bed. Then he cried out to the Lord and said, "O Lord my God, have You also brought tragedy on the widow with whom I lodge, by killing her son?" And he stretched himself out on the child three times, and cried out to the Lord and said, "O Lord my God, I pray, let this child's soul come back to him." Then the Lord heard the voice of Elijah; and the soul of the child came back to him, and he revived.

And Elijah took the child and brought him down from the upper room into the house, and gave him to his mother. And Elijah said, "See, your son lives!"

Then the woman said to Elijah, "Now by this I know that you are a man of God, and that the word of the Lord in your mouth is the truth."
