WHAT IS REVIVAL:

"When I speak of revival, I'm not thinking of high pressure evangelism, I'm not thinking of crusades or special efforts convened and organized by man. That is not in my mind at all. Successful evangelism sees 100's or even 1000's of people making decisions for Christ, but the community remains unchanged and the churches continue much the same as they were before. Revival is something altogether different. 1 Cor 12:1 - 11

1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant: 2 You know that you were Gentiles, carried away to these dumb idols, however you were led. 3 Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.

4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. 6 And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. 7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all: 8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, 9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. 11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

In 1 Cor 1:10 - 15

- 10 Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. 11 For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. 12 Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." 13 Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?
- 14 I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius, 15 lest anyone should say that I had baptized in my own name.

1 Cor 3:1

'And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes (mere infants) in Christ.'



"It is possible to have strong spiritual gifts in your life, but be way off-base in the way you use them. It is possible to have spiritual gifts and not understand their correct use. And it's possible when you're not personally familiar with a particular spiritual gift to have no appreciation for it, or even teach that it has passed away.

The Corinthian church was rich in spiritual gifts - but weak in wisdom. As Paul began this letter, he told the Corinthians, "You do not lack any spiritual gift" (1:7). The church needs teaching. They need perspective from Paul who has had a lot of experience with spiritual gifts - their use, misuse, and disuse."

The Ministry of the Holy Spirit

- He is the Helper John 14:16, 14:26, 15:26, 16:7.
- He is to dwell in us AND be with us John 14:17
- He will teach us all things John 14:26
- He will bring to our remembrance all things Jesus said to us John 14:16
- He testifies of Jesus John 15:26
- He convicts the World of sin, because they don't believe in Jesus. John 16 He convicts the world of righteousness, because Jesus went to the Father and we see Him no more. John 16
- He convicts the world of judgement, because the ruler of this world is judged. John 16
- He will guide us into all truth John 16
- He will NOT speak on His own authority, whatever He hears, He speaks. John 16.
- He will tell us of things to come. John 16
- He will glorify Jesus. John 16



The Ministry of the Holy Spirit

- He will take of what is Christs and declare it to us. John 16
- The Spirit helps us in our weaknesses Rom 8:26
- He will pray through us the perfect will of God. Rom 8
- He will reveal and show us the deep things of God, even Gods very thoughts
- He will show us what God has prepared for those who love Him 1 Cor 2
- ullet He will show us all that we have been freely given in God 1 Cor 2
- He teaches us to speak spiritual things 1 Cor 2:13
- He empowers us Acts 1:8
- \bullet The Holy Spirit separates us for the more specific work to which we are called Acts 13
- The Holy Spirit sends us out to do Kingdom work Acts 13
- The Holy Spirit shows us the future Acts 11:24
- He will give us specific direction Acts 16.

- He gives us the ability to worship in spirit and in truth John 4:24
- We are sealed with the Holy Spirit as a guarantee... As He is our 'matan', our bridal gift. *Eph* 1, John 14, Matt 26

- We are empowered by the Spirit Acts 1:8
- We can grow strong in the Spirit Luke 1:80 and Luke 2:40
- We are to ask for the Spirit Luke 11:13
- We are to worship in Spirit John 4:23 24
