

### Luke 24:1 - 7


1 Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared. 2 But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. 3 Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. 4 And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments. 5 Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, "WHY DO YOU SEEK THE LIVING AMONG THE DEAD? 6 HE IS NOT HERE, BUT IS **RISEN!** Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, 7 saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of ALIVE! sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again."




#### Matt 28:1 - 7

1 Now after the Sabbath, as the first day of the week began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb. 2 And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it. 3 His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. 4 And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men.


5 But the angel answered and said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. 6 HE IS NOT HERE; FOR HE IS RISEN, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay. 7 And go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead, and indeed He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him. Behold, I have told you."



The resurrection of Jesus Christ is the central pillar of faith. It is the crowning event in Gods redemptive history, the very cornerstone of Christianity. The resurrection is both the foundation of the gospel and the guarantee of Heaven.






#### John 11:25 - 26

Rom 10:9 "If you confess with your mouth the LORD Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved."






### Gen 2:15 - 17






#### Rom 8:3

"For what the law could NOT do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh on account of sin."


#### NLT


### Phil 2:6 - 11


### 1 Cor 15:12 - 19

12 Now if Christ is preached that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead? 13 But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ is not risen. 14 And if Christ is not risen, then our preaching is empty and your faith is also empty. 15 Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God, because we have testified of God that He raised up Christ, whom He did not raise up—if in fact the dead do not rise. 16 For if the dead do not rise, then Christ is not risen. 17 AND IF CHRIST IS NOT RISEN, YOUR FAITH IS FUTILE; YOU ARE STILL IN YOUR SINS! 18 Then also those who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. 19 If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of ALIVE! all men the most pitiable.






# The Life of God IN you, saves you:

### **1. From living apart from God.** John 17:1 - 3

1 Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, 2 as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.




# The Life of God IN you, saves you:

### 2. From Yourself Rom 6:6

6 We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin.

#### Rom 8:10 - 11


And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.



### 3. From the fear of death, Jesus is our prototype. Heb 2:14 - 15

Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. 15 Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of death.
