## Gentle (Two parts)

1. It is an attitude of spirit by which we accept God's dealings with us as good and do not dispute or resist.
2. In English, since the term 'meekness' might suggest weakness, but it is a condition of mind and heart which demonstrates gentleness, not in weakness, but in power. It is a balance born in strength of character.

# Easy and my burden light

1. The word denotes that which is useful, pleasant, good, comfortable, suitable and serviceable.
2. The legalistic religious system was a severe burden, but service to Jesus does not chafe because it is well-fitting and built on a personal relationship with God by the indwelling Spirit.

- To learn, teach, instruct.
- Increase in understanding of the pupil.
- A pupil / disciple relationship.
- One teaches and the other learns or assimilates.

- The main aim of 'didasko' when teaching is the shaping of the will of the pupil.
- Through repeated experience this is that happens.
  - You pay a price.
  - You experience failure.
  - It is a dying to self.
  - This is where the fruit of the Spirit begins to develop.
